Dr Quah entered NUS Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine from 2007 to 2012, graduating with MB.BS (Singapore). She subsequently joined the Singhealth Emergency Medicine Residency Program from 2013 to 2018 and obtained master's in medicine (Emergency Medicine) in 2016. Participated in the Singapore Chief Residency Program (SCRCP) from 2016-2017 and served as the Singhealth Emergency Medicine Program Chief Resident from 2017-2018.

Dr Quah joined SGH Department of Emergency Medicine in 2018, appointed as DEM Assistant Director of Emergency Department Action and Response Team (EDART) and Assistant Commander, Disaster Site Medical Command, MOH in 2019, promoted to Deputy Commander in 2022. In 2020, she obtained European Master's in Disaster Medicine and the same year, she was appointed as Member in SGH Emergency Preparedness Committee. She was appointed as Consultant, Integrated Operations Division, MOH in 2021.
