TICKETING & REGISTRATION

Q: Is the After Party event open to the public?

Yes, it is open to the public.

Q: Is this a ticketed event?

Yes, it is a ticketed event, and entry will be granted via wristbands issued at registration.

Q: Will wristbands be issued?

Yes, **yellow wristbands** will be issued on-site after successful registration. The wristband serves as your pass into the event.

Q: How do I get access to the event?

Admission is free and open to all, but limited to the **first 1,000 attendees** on a **first-come, first-served basis**. To enter, you must **register in person and collect your wristband** at the venue between **1:00PM to 4:00PM**. Each person is entitled to **one wristband only**, and collection must be done individually.

Q: Where is the registration counter?

Registration counters for wristband collection will be located **outside Hall D** at Marina Bay Sands, Basement 2. Just follow the signage or ask our volunteers!

Q: Can I collect wristbands on behalf of my friends?

Each attendee must register and collect their own wristband in person. This is to ensure fair distribution on a **first-come, first-served** basis.

Q: What if I miss the wristbands collection window?

As this is a free event, we cannot guarantee availability of wristbands as they may be fully redeemed. We recommend arriving early to secure your spot.

EVENT TIMINGS & ENTRY FLOW

Q: What time should I arrive?

Here's the timeline you should follow:

- **1PM–4PM:** Registration and wristband collection
- **5PM:** Bag check begins
- **6PM:** Doors open for entry
- **7PM–9PM:** Let the performances begin!

Q: What happens during bag check?

To ensure everyone's safety, all bags will be thoroughly checked at entry. Please travel light to speed things up.

Q: What is the entry flow like?

After your bag is checked at 5PM, you will be guided to enter the hall from 6PM onwards.

SECURITY & SAFETY

Q: What items are not allowed inside?

For everyone's safety, the following are **prohibited**:

Smoking, outside food and drinks, weapons, sharp items, strollers, pets, whistles, umbrellas, noise devices, lasers, fireworks, drugs, flammables, oversized banners, alcohol, helmets, or any hazardous items.

Q: Can I bring my own professional camera?

To ensure an enjoyable experience for all guests, video cameras, monopods, tripods, selfie sticks, audio recording devices, and professional cameras are not permitted at the event.

Q: My child is in a stroller / an elderly family member is in a wheelchair and wants to attend. Is there a designated spot for their stroller or wheelchair?

For safety reasons, strollers and wheelchairs are not permitted inside the venue. They must be parked outside the venue at the owner's own risk and should not block aisle ways or exits. Please note that this is an all-standing event, with no seating available.

Q: I am under 12 years old, can I still attend the After Party event?

Children under 12 years old must be accompanied by a responsible adult aged 18 years or older at all times.

Q: Will there be medical assistance on site?

Yes! Our first aid team will be stationed nearby for any emergencies. There will also be a Red Cross Non-Emergency Medical Transport on standby.

Q: Is re-entry allowed?

Yes, re-entry is allowed as long as your wristband is intact and visible. Please do not remove or tamper with it to avoid issues at the door.

Q: I tore or lost my wristband. Can I still enter?

Unfortunately, you will not be allowed entry without a valid, untampered wristband, even if you have previously registered. Please take care of your wristband!

Q: Can I bring my own banner or lightstick?

For safety reasons, banners and lightsticks are not recommended. We want to ensure a safe environment for all guests and performers. Your cheers and energy will be more than enough!
