Risk Management	<u>Learning Outcome:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grasp risk management as a holistic, systemic approach. • Recognize different risk domains • Become familiar with available risk management instruments
Situational Awareness	<u>Learning Outcome:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Define situational awareness. • Discuss the importance of situational awareness for humanitarians. • Learn effective techniques for maintaining situational awareness in deployment conditions. • Recognize Tell Tale Indicators for enhanced awareness.
Vehicle Checkpoints	<u>Learning Outcome:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understand the differences between Vehicle Checkpoints (VCP), roadblocks, and ambushes. • Learn how to safely approach, transit, and exit a VCP. • Identify risk mitigation strategies when encountering an ambush.
Physical Security	<u>Learning Outcome:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recognize security considerations when selecting accommodation. • Learn physical security risk management strategies (4 D's and the "Onion"). • Appreciate the importance of rehearsing contingency plans.
Information Security	<u>Learning Outcome:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explain the importance of information security for deployed humanitarians. • Apply a simple framework for Cyber Risk Context. • Understand digital footprints and strategies to reduce them. • Learn about phishing and prevention measures.
